



PSP60704 - Advanced Diploma of Government (Strategic Procurement)

Overview

This specialist qualification covers the competencies required of personnel responsible for the management of strategic procurement in public sector organisations.

Who Should Attend

This qualification is designed for people managing strategic procurement in the public sector in a supervisor or manager role.

Entry Requirements

To be eligible to enter this Advanced Diploma you will need to:

- be mature age (20 years or over)
- be currently working in, or contracted to the public sector with a minimum of three years full-time work experience
- have access to the specific work practices and procedures required to demonstrate competency in the units undertaken.
